Hot DOG Daycare Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations are designed to insure a safe and fun environment for your fur baby while at Hot DOG Daycare.

1. Payment is due at time of pick up or in advance if purchasing a package for multiple visits.
2. Daycare hours are 8:00am-5:30pm Monday-Friday. Reservations are required at least 24 hours in advance. We do have limited space so reservations for same day are dependent on availability. Please be sure to give 24 hours notice if cancelling and call ASAP if sick.
3. HAIR of the DOG / HOT DOG Daycare must have the following on file before your baby can attend: Enrollment Form, Rules and Regulations, Owner Agreement, Pre-screen Aptitude Test, Safety Statement, and a Copy of Current Vaccinations
4. Rough housing is what dogs do, however, we do not allow aggressive behavior. We promote an atmosphere that is social and conducive to a fun, safe and healthy environment.
5. We understand that all pets have bad days, however, if a dog displays mild non-social behavior, he/she will be:

 - _____ a. Put into a time-out that consists of 5 minutes alone in a kennel to calm down.
 - _____ b. Asked to leave daycare, if the behavior persists and puts other dogs and/or the caregiver in danger.
 - _____ c. Can not return to daycare, if there is no change in behavior.
8. We make every effort to ensure the safety of every dog. Doggy daycare isn't like a children's daycare (child may fall down or catch a cold or even encounter a bully). The risks with doggy daycare are a little different --- dogs play with paws, nails and teeth so you may occasionally see a scratch or two.
9. Many owners may not want to know if their baby misbehaved. It is our goal to keep parents up to date with anything that concerns your fur baby. We will let you know if they had a time out, had a scuffle, and also when they have a great day. This way if the baby is asked to be picked up or told not they can not turn, it will not be a surprise.
10. Your pet **MUST** be spayed or neutered and we **MUST** have proof on file from vet. We reserve the right to turn away any dog that shows unsuitable behavior for safe play with other dogs.
11. It's best if you feed your dog before coming to daycare. The staff will only feed a noon meal if provided by owners at the time of drop off. Dogs will be fed OUT of sight of other dogs to ensure no favoritism or issues. We will (with mom and dad's permission) give treats throughout the day for good behavior. If your baby requires a specific treat, you are responsible for providing unless I have in stock.
12. Have your dog eliminate before coming into daycare in the morning. This will allow more of a play/learning time in the morning and walks in late morning. If a special collar/leash is required please leave this with us and we will return at pick up. We have our own, but nothing special.
13. Please alert caregiver of any changes in your dogs behavior or condition (loose stools, medication, lethargy, vomiting, recent vaccinations, etc.)
14. Only owner may pick up your fur baby unless arrangements are made in advance. We want to avoid any missing children.
